No Quarantine!

As of 15th May 2022, international travelers can enter Vietnam without having to submit a COVID test result, vaccination proof, and health declaration QR code. You are still liable for having medical insurance plans with minimum cover of US\$10,000 (COVID included) prior to arriving in Vietnam.

Visa Exemption

You are eligible for a visa exemption to enter Vietnam if you are **citizen of the following countries** and your **trip duration is within the allowed period**. Check your eligibility below.

To stay beyond this number of days, you may apply for a visa extension upon your arrival in Vietnam.

14 DAYS BRUNEI, MYANMAR

15 DAYS BELARUS, DENMARK, ITALY, JAPAN, FINLAND, FRANCE, GERMANY, NORWAY, RUSSIA, SOUTH KOREA (ROK), SPAIN, SWEDEN, THE UNITED KINGDOM

21 DAYS THE PHILIPPINES

30 DAYS CAMBODIA, INDONESIA, LAOS, MALAYSIA, SINGAPORE, THAILAND

E-Visa

If you are not eligible for a visa exemption, you can obtain a tourist e-visa yourself by [following the instructions here](#).

E-visa is **single entry visa**, a valid for 30 days. E-visa fee is USD 25, the processing time is 3 working days. You will receive your code by email to print your visa.

Visa on Arrival

You need to apply for a **Visa on Arrival** in the following cases:

- You're NOT eligible for either visa exemption or e-Visa; OR
- If you are planning a **multiple-entry visit** or a **stay of more than 30 days**.

In order to be granted a Visa on Arrival, you need to obtain a **Visa Letter Approval** prior to your flight to Vietnam. Follow the detailed instructions on our [Vietnam Travel Visa Guide](#) if you'd like to apply yourself.

TIPS:

- The visa approval letter can also be obtained through ITS Vietnam's visa service (fee applied) if you are not able to submit your visa paperwork in person at the nearest Vietnamese Embassy.
- You will need to pay your visa stamp fee in USD or Vietnamese Dong on arrival at the airport.
