A New Expressway to Ha Long Bay is Almost Finished



A new expressway connecting the world-famous Ha Long Bay with the Hanoi-Hai Phong Expressway is almost finished. The expressway is expected to open to traffic on September 2, Vietnam's Independence Day.

Once the project acceptance is complete, the speed limit would go up to the designed 100 kph.

The expressway is set to reduce the Ha Long-Hanoi commute by 50 km to 130 km, and the Ha Long-Hai Phong route from 75 km to just 25 km.
