Opening soon: Ha Long – Hai Phong Highway. Travelling time from Hanoi to Halong takes 2 hours instead of 4,5 hours



After over three years of construction, Ha Long-Hai Phong expressway project, which is about 50 km long connecting Ha Long city (Quang Ninh) with Hai Phong city, is almost complete. The road is expected to open in September 2018.

When the Ha Long – Hai phong expressway goes into use, travelling time Haiphong to Halong Bay take 1 hr and from Hanoi to Haiphong takes 1,5 hours. Travelling time from Hanoi to the famous bay cut in

half, totally only from 2 to 2,5 hours. Such a good news for Travellers who dream of visiting the famous World Heritage Ha Long Bay!

Water puppet show in Hanoi

The water puppet show in Hanoi is a representation of a traditional Vietnamese theatre show that dates back to about 1,000 years during the Ly Dynasty. Located at Dinh Tien Hoang street, nearby Hoan Kiem Lake, Thang Long Water Puppet Theater is a familiar address for both domestic tourists and foreign ones, who want to enjoy water puppet shows and discover the beauty of this unique Vietnam traditional art.

Jonah Show in Hanoi

Taking place at the contemporary Star Galaxy Theater in Hanoi's Ba Dinh District, the show depicts a Vietnam love story, with insights into life and culture in Hanoi. A O Show



This was an excellent show that depicts Vietnamese life in a most original way. Experience the richness of Vietnamese culture with this spectacular hour-long show mixing the acrobatics of contemporary circus with the theatricality of the stage, the musicality of a moon string instrument, and, above all, poetry. A O show is frequently organized in Hanoi, Ho Chi Minh City, and Hoi An.

Hoi An Memory Show

Hoi An Memories is the biggest scenery show in Vietnam that won 2 Vietnamese Record: "The largest outdoor stage" and "the most daily crowded performers show". The show was launched in March 18 in Hoi An City - one of the world heritages. The capacity of seats is 3.300 everyday.



Ao Dai Show in Ho Chi Minh City

The Ao Dai Museum's Si Hoang Show on Saigon's walking street Nguyen Hue every Wednesday, Thursday, Saturday and Sunday. The show reveals some Ao Dai designs from the 18th century until today but also features the traditional costumes of 54 ethnic groups living in Vietnam.
